 - o DO NOT DELETE ANY PICTURES FROM THE CAMERA!!! If you don't want me to see it you probably shouldn't be taking it! It is easy to make a small mistake and delete the pictures from the photographers before you and that makes people VERY unhappy!
- Be respectful
 - o If it's not yours; don't touch it! Leave things alone! (this is a good rule to follow no matter where you are!)
 - O You <u>must</u> ask someone's permission to take their picture <u>BEFORE</u> you take it. If they say no then graciously respect their privacy.
